God uses Daniel to interpret the king's dream • Daniel 2:1–49

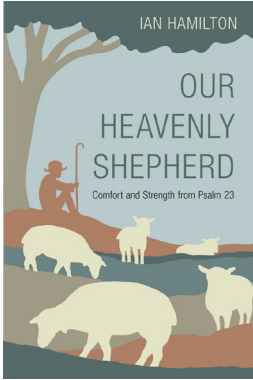
Principle: Man will be comforted or warned by God's sovereign plan for human history.
