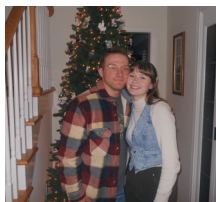

Guest speaker Tom Pennington will preach on Sunday, October 18th as we honor the Hardy's 20th anniversary at TCBC.

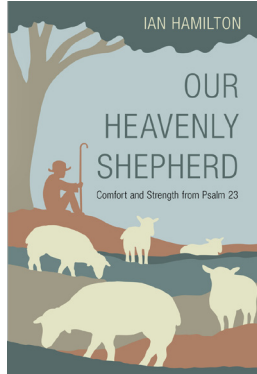
ADVENTURE CLUB STUDENT REGISTRATION
